Landscape Committee If you have taken note of our gorgeous common areas, you have Martha Werth to thank. She is now serving her *ninth* year as Deane Gardenhome Landscape Committee chairperson. The Landscape Committe is responsible to maintain the common areas. The common areas are the areas outside the property lines adjacent to homeowner walls. Architecture Committee The Architectural Committee is chartered to review and approve plans and specifications submitted by Homeowners for approval, as required by the *Declaration of Covenants & Restrictions of the Deane Gardenhome Association, Article IX, Sections 1 & 2.* These include, but are not limited to, house repainting, wall replacement and all new construction. If you have a question about architectural improvements, CC&R conformance, architectural plans, style compliance, or changes to paint colors, please contact Joe Mulvihill, Architecture Committee Chairperson.

President's Office Ivan Hulka will continue to preside over regular meetings of the Board, set policy, agenda, schedules, priorities, and assigns tasks. He will be monitoring the DGHA website deanegardenhomes@yahoo. com with the goal of better communication and early identification of situations needing attention.

Vice President's Office Richard Boemer will continue to share the responsibilities of the President's office in Ivan's absence and as delegated. He will coordinate with real estate and escrow authorities during changes in Gardenhome ownership, ensuring that new DGH buyers receive copies of the CC&Rs at an early stage in the transactions and that the escrow will include any obligations of both the seller and the buyer.

Treasurer's Office Treasurer Scott Abeyta prepares and mails your regular dues statements, monitors timely collection of dues, does the banking and pays our expenses and taxes. One of the Treasurer's toughest jobs is to prepare the yearly budget, submit it for approval and make sure that spending stays within the budget. The DGHA has expenses which must be serviced regularly, such as Huntington Beach Municipal Services, the landscaping contractor, etc.

Secretary's Office Lore Hynes will continue as Secretary for the Board, and is responsible to serve notice of meetings and proceedings of the Board and the General Membership, and to record the votes and keep the minutes. The Secretary's Office also handles general correspondence and record maintenance.

Member-at-Large Patrick Stanton and John Hodge will support and assist the various board members as needed at board meetings.

The State of California has extended and modified the emergency drought regulations. The modified regulations took effect June 1, 2016 and have been extended through January 2017.

Effective July 5, 2016, the City of Huntington Beach adopted Level 1 Water Restrictions.

- Use of automated irrigation is limited to Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.
- Irrigation is prohibited between 9 am and 5 pm.
- Irrigation is limited to no more than 10 minutes per day per station.
- No excessive water runoff from irrigation onto sidewalks or streets.
- No watering during or 48 hours after measurable rainfall.
- Washing down hard or paved surfaces is prohibited.
- Leaks must be repaired within 72 hours of notification.
