BOARD OF DIRECTORS

POSITION: PRESIDENT

DUTIES: Presides over regular meeting of the Board, sets policy, agenda, schedules, priorities and assigns tasks. Monitors the DGHA website and communicates CC&R violations.

POSITION: VICE PRESIDENT

DUTIES: The Vice President will share the responsibilities of the President's office and as delegated. Coordinate with real estate and escrow authorities during changes in Gardenhome ownership, ensuring that new DGH buyers receive copies of the CC&R/Bylaws, outstanding balance owed to the Association. Coordinate escrow transfer fee.

POSITION: SECRETARY
